

Reward Ceremony 2016 for Wangu Township's Integrated School & Lianjiang Central Primary School

The Chongren Foundation has cooperated with Ya'an Mingshan Education Bureau on sponsoring Lianjiang Central Primary School & Wangu Township's Integrated School to build new classrooms, purchase IT facilities since the Sichuan earthquake in 2008.

Since 2010, launched by Dr. Mark Qiu, the Chongren Foundation and Mingshan Education Bureau organize annual Reward Ceremony on the Children's Day to reward outstanding teachers and students, in order to motivate students as well as to continue outstanding performing.

The 6th Reward Ceremony was conducted in Wangu Township's Integrated School on June 1st, 2016. Mr. Song Xiaohai, on behalf of the Chongren Foundation, rewarded 10 outstanding teachers (6 Wanggu and 4 Lianjiang) and 17 students (10 Wanggu and 7 Lianjiang) with honorary certificates and cash bonuses. Both teachers and students expressed their gratitude to the Chongren Foundation by a rich program of dances, songs, speeches and paintings.

Visits to Wangu Township's Integrated School & Lianjiang Central Primary School

On June 7th 2016, Dr. Mark Qiu on behalf of the Chongren Foundation paid the visit to the Wangu and the Lianjiang, and conducted meetings with Headmasters (Mr. Lu from Wangu and Mr. Yang from Liangjiang) and some teachers. During the meetings, both Headmasters had expressed their appreciations and gratitude to the Chongren Foundation.

Wangu has ~700 students (Secondary 190, Primary 465, and 50 Kindergarten) and 45 teachers. Under the Foundation's support, the School's new teaching building had put into service since June 2015. Due to the continuously improved facilities and education quality, the School was awarded the 2nd Award in a recent School Assessment. It intends to focus on improving its courses of sports & arts by recruiting more qualified teachers. Next years, the School plans to revamp its sport facilities, and has proposed the request of financial support to the Foundation.

Lianjiang has ~500 students (significantly increased from ~300 students before the Foundation's support) and 25 teachers. In the past year, newly built Teacher Dormitory provided comfortable accommodations for single young teachers. Besides, the School was dedicated in quality enhancement, and was ranked No. 7 in 2015, and No. 3 in 2014's School Assessment (out of 30 peers in the region). In future, the School also plans to revamp its sport facilities, and put a focus on the quality of sports & art courses. Furthermore, according to Mr. Yang, the Foundation only rewarded 4 teachers. However, several teachers achieved similar scores in performance reviews. The School decided to let those teachers share the Foundation's cash bonuses. Therefore, Mr. Yang is wondering whether the Foundation could increase the number of Teachers Rewards or the amount of cash bonuses.
